

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND PLAYERS

You are responsible for reading and understanding this information. If you have any questions, contact: questions@napalittleleague.org

- Tryouts are MANDATORY for all players league age 9 and up. If you do not attend tryouts, you cannot be selected or assigned to a team without specific approval from the Board of Directors.
 - If you cannot attend tryouts, contact a board member as soon as possible.
 - If your child is sick the morning of tryouts, a parent should come to the tryouts and check in for the player.
- **It is possible we will have more players than teams.** We encourage you to sign up as soon as possible.
- There are NO exceptions to the required documents
 - Only COMPLETE registrations will be accepted
 - **DO NOT MAIL IN YOUR APPLICATION**
 - If a player is not living with a parent, the guardian will need to provide a copy of the court document granting them custody of the child.
 - The proof of residency documents must show the player, parent, or court appointed guardian's name.

- Players and parents CANNOT request a certain team, manager, or level of play (the Rookie Division teams are generally formed by school of attendance).
- During the season, if a player refuses a "call up" (a request for the player to move up to the next level as a replacement player), the player will be moved to another team within their current level (move up or move over policy). Full details can be found on our web site. Minor B players refusing a call up also forfeit eligibility for the Minor B All Star Game.
- Negative conduct will not be tolerated. Umpires and Board Members can "eject" spectators from the park.
